Regular 1st Offense, ARS 28-1381 A1. Impaired to slightest degree by alcohol, vapor, a legal drug, or an illegal drug***, or A2. Alcohol level of .080 or more within 2 hours of driving, or A3. Any illegal drug in your body even if not impaired.***	10 <u>-9 suspended*</u> 1 (24 consecutive hours)	\$1,460	\$70	\$20	12 months	Judge may order it.	Apparently not allowed.
Extreme 1st Offense, ARS 28-1382 Alcohol level of .150 - .199 within 2 hours of driving.***	30 <u>-20 suspended*</u> 10 consecutive **	\$2,710	\$700	\$20	12 months	Judge may order it.	30 days or more, if ordered.

Regular 2nd Offense, ARS 28-1381 Committed same way as regular first offense, with a regular or extreme DUI in prior 7 years.***	90 <u>-60 suspended*</u> 30 consecutive **	\$3,420	\$2,100	\$20	12 months	Judge must order at least 30 hours.	Apparently not allowed.
Extreme 2nd Offense, ARS 28-1382 Alcohol level of .150 - .199 or more within 2 hours of driving, with a regular or extreme DUI in prior 7 years.***	120 <u>-60 suspended*</u> 60 consecutive **	\$3,670	\$4,200	\$20	12 months	Judge must order at least 30 hours.	90 days or more, if ordered.
Super Extreme 2nd Offense, ARS 28-1382 Alcohol level of .20 or more within 2 hours of driving, with a regular or extreme DUI in prior 7 years.***	180 ** 0 suspended. 90 must be consecutive.**	\$4,590	\$12,600	\$20	24 months	Judge must order at least 30 hours.	90 days or more, if ordered.

* These days in jail are suspended on the condition you attend mandatory alcohol/drug screening (evaluation) and 16-36 hours of classes, normally at your expense.

**The judge may allow work/school release 12 hours per day, 5 days per week after you serve 48 consecutive hours in jail.

*** Your license will be revoked for 1 year, with no driving for any reason if: (1) You are convicted of A1 and the court abstract sent to MVD has the drug box marked "yes" for illegal drugs, or (2) You are convicted of A3 (driving with any illegal drug in your body), or (3) You are convicted of 2 offenses of DUI, reckless driving, racing on the highway or any combination of 2 of these offenses with offense dates within 7 years. Your license will be revoked for 3 years, with no driving for any reason if you are convicted of 3 DUIs with offense dates within 7 years. See the flowchart for more details regarding your license.

**** Some of these may be waived depending on financial ability. Some courts have additional local fees.
